

Telehealth Visit Tips

We welcome you to our telehealth program! Many concerns can be addressed via video visits. However, there may be certain times when we recommend an in-office same-day or next-day follow-up visit based on your child's symptoms (for example, for respiratory symptoms or if testing is needed).

Preparing for Your Telemedicine Visit

- 1. Check Your Technology:
 - Ensure your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) is charged and has a stable internet connection.
 - Test your microphone and camera to make sure they are working properly.
- 2. Choose a Quiet, Private Location:
 - Find a quiet place where you won't be interrupted. Ensure good lighting so the doctor can see you clearly.
- 3. Gather Necessary Information:
 - Write down any symptoms, questions, or concerns you want to discuss.
 - It is helpful if you have a scale at home to have your child's weight ready. Have a thermometer available in case we need a temperature reading.

During the Visit

- 1. Be On Time:
 - Log in 10-15 minutes early to ensure everything is set up and ready.
- 2. Communicate Clearly:
 - Speak clearly and describe your symptoms in detail. If you have visible symptoms, show them to the doctor using your camera.

3. Ask Questions:

• Don't hesitate to ask questions if you don't understand something. It's important to be clear about your diagnosis and treatment plan.

After the Visit

- 1. Follow Up:
 - Follow any instructions given by your doctor. Schedule follow-up appointments if necessary.
 - You can view your after-visit summary (AVS) in MyChart for more details on your plan, including any medications that are prescribed.

2. Medication and Treatment:

• Ensure you understand how to take any prescribed medications and follow the treatment plan.

Additional Tips

- Dress Appropriately: Wear comfortable clothing that allows you to show any areas of concern easily.
- Minimize Distractions: Turn off notifications on your device and let others know you are in a medical appointment.
